

Sahara Welfare Foundation imparts skill development training to celebrate International Women's Day

Lucknow, 8th March 2022: Sahara Welfare Foundation, today in its Bakshi ka Talab Centre, celebrates the International Women's Day with the girls and women from the adjoining villages. A narration given on different schemes aimed at women's empowerment and the ways and means of availing them was also made for the benefit of women attending the program. On the occasion a competition of Mehandi art, Paper Craft, Painting Art and Musical Chair was held. This Centre of Sahara Welfare Foundation at Bakshi Ka Talab, has imparted skill development training largely to adolescent girls and needy women from nearby and adjacent villages. For last six years, this Centre of Sahara Welfare Foundation is operational, where women are trained with trades like sewing and embroidery, computer proficiency, art of applying mehendi and paper bag making etc.
